25	Police Department. It will greatly enhance our



1	communication with our neighboring police
2	agencies North Myrtle Beach, the County
3	and will put us on par with other police
4	departments in our communications efforts and
5	with other municipalities. We hope to have the
6	purchase completed. They have to be ordered.
7	And I think correct me if I'm wrong, Chief
8	I think it's gonna be close to about six
9	weeks to get 'em purchased, fabricated and sent
10	to us around that time frame. Item B, we
11	got a letter. I issued the Council the
12	approval from HUD to draw down funds for the
13	renovation of the park playground across from
14	the Community Center. The Municipal
15	Association is leading the effort to do the
16	public advertisement and recommendations for
17	selection of a contractor to do the entire
18	renovation of the park. But we got clearance.
19	It was held up I announced in last meeting
20	due to the environmental reviews that had to
21	be completed. Took longer than expected, but
22	we have the go-ahead to get a contractor in to
23	start that work. Hopefully by next meeting
24	I'll have a definitive timeline on how long it
25	will take to get the renovations completed at



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1	that site. Last thing I have is that Mr.	
2	Waylands, the owner of the recently installed	
3	digital billboard on Highway 17 and 30th,	
4	graciously has donated three months of free	
5	advertisement for the Town of Atlantic Beach to	
6	promote positive events and programs that will	
7	benefit the Town. If any of the Council or	
8	residents have any suggestions of anything that	
9	would be of interest to advertise during that	
10	time period, please contact me and we will see	
11	if we can get it approved and posted on the new	
12	digital sign. Like to thank Mr. Waylands for	
13	his donation and contribution to the Town of	
14	Atlantic Beach. That's all I have, Mayor.
