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proposed zoning that was in the September 25th Planning document submitted to Council approval. The concern was that four parcels of land along 29th Avenue was zoned -- or rezoned MS-2, which restricted single family housing development on 29th Avenue. After discussions with the Planning Chairman, Vice Chair, the (inaudible) the intent οf the Planning Commission's recommendation was that all 29th remains residential, R-2. So, the four parcels of land along 29th Avenue are being changed back to their original designation as R-2 residential, as opposed to MS-2. brought out by a resident during the public hearing on November 4th.

Also, I'd like to announce to the public that effective on tomorrow, the Police Department will be temporarily moving to the Community Center at 1010 32nd Avenue South for improvement and enhancements to the Police Department. I don't have a definitive time frame for how long the transition or temporary relocation will take place, but we will keep Hopefully, it's no more than Council notified. 30 to 45 days.
