AMENDED FORM OF GOVERNMENT

WHEREAS, the municipality of the Town of Atlantic Beach is incorporated under the laws of the State of South Carolina,

AND WHEREAS, a charter has been issued to the above municipality of the Town of Atlantic Beach,

AND WHEREAS, Section 47-26 of the 1962 Code of Laws, as amended, requires that all municipalities adopt a specific form of government,

AND WHEREAS, an Ordinance was filed with the Secretary of State on 2/16/96, Ordinance No. 93-2, setting forth:

FIRST The name of the municipality is the Town of Atlantic Beach.

SECOND: An Ordinance, effective 8/17/93, changed the form of government from a Mayor-Council Form to Council-Manager Form.
