I'm going to check with the guvs about the Junkyard Band out of D.C. And I got another -- a band called Live in the -- I'm sorry, I just went right into it. I'm supposed to come in here and giving you all, letting you know the entertainment. There are some of the members who wanted to know the entertainment that we're having for the stage this year.

- Revelation. We got this young boy I just
- 14 | signed last week called -- on my label called
- 15 | Fresha Da God, he a real good artist, clean --
- 16 | clean rap. It's real good, based on like a
- Jazzy Jeff type of artist. I think he gonna do
- 18 real well.
- 19 | MR. DAVID: And if you can get the Junk Yard Band,
- 20 that'd be really nice.
- 21 MR. GORE: Excuse me.
- 22 | MR. DAVID: And if you could Junk Yard Band, that'd
- 23 be real nice.
- 24 MR. GORE: Matter of fact, I'm leaving right now to
- go meet with a gentleman about doing the --

getting the Junk Yard Band. If we can come to the terms on the numbers.

As a -- as some of you know, Steve Fera worked with us on a proposal to change from florescent to LED lighting in the town hall and the community center. This is gonna save the town over \$25,000 dollars over a period of five years. Ron -- Ron Kirby, Michael Graves (ph) and Rodney Brown worked on the entertainment evaluation committee. Charles Russell worked

1 the clean up evaluation committee, along 2 with Councilwoman Jackie Gore. Bruce Robinson, 3 Dr. Sheila Robertson and Titus Leakes worked on 4 the evaluation committee for the re-write of 5 our comprehensive plan land management 6 ordinance and master plan. And I just want to 7 say thank you for the help that residents and 8 property owners provide whenever we call.

MS. GORE: I want to say something.

MS. CHEATHAM: Oh.

MS. GORE: This right here (inaudible) I see that we had the guys down there parking the cars and there's been a few coming down there but if we don't get them people some umbrellas or something down there, they're gonna have to call -- have to call 9-1-1. They need to get some tents down there ---

MR. DAVID: We'll provide umbrellas and we'll talk to the parking company who actually hired them to do something else. They're talking about building a little structure.

10		We also are establishing some social media
11		sites for those people younger than myself.
12		Instagram and Facebook will be up and running
13		also. Both of the EV charging stations, the
14		one right outside the community center on 30th
15		Avenue are operational. The Beautification
16		Committee has already told me that or
17		complained about the way they look. And so
18		we'll be asking for some volunteers to paint
19		them.

It's going you've heard us talking for the past couple of 1 years about our involvement with the Thriving 2 Communities and the Department o f 3 Transportation Plan. Well our three years is 4 coming to a close and so this is our final 5 event and we want to do something that reminds 6 us of them and -- and ourselves.
