- 2 MR. DAVID: All right, second reading of Ordinance
- 3 Number 6-2025?

- 8 MS. PEREIRA: Councilman Edward Campbell?

- 12 MS. PEREIRA: Mayor Pro Tem John David?

- 15 MR. DAVID: Next we're moving to new business. We
- have Ordinance Number 8-2025, an ordinance to
- 17 define criminal offenses, miscellaneous
- 18 provisions and penalties first reading. Ms.
- 19 Cheatham?

- 21 council and residents, the purpose of this
- 22 ordinance is to cautify some of the -- the
- issues that residents, as well as council
- 24 people were observing. There are issues
- regarding loitering. There's issues around the

- abandonment -- abandonment of autos. And so
  the attorney has been working with the police
  department to try and strengthen some of the
  things that have been going on that people have
  found offensive. I'd be glad to answer any
  questions that you might have.
  - MS. TAYLOR: No questions, just the comment that having read the first reading, that I think the citizens and residents of the town would appreciate this effort to make our town more secure.
  - MR. DAVID: And I think it does deal with hate crimes and civil rights in the town, as well as making sure the beach front is safe and the town is safe harassment, loitering, people that are -- that have not -- that's gone unchecked in time. So I hope that you will -- if it hadn't been posted on the website ---

- 25 it.

2	contract with a new Town Manager and I'm
3	pleased to announce that Mr. Adrian Jones has
4	agreed to become the Town Manager of Atlantic
5	Beach effective June the 2nd. I'd be glad to
6	answer any questions that I might have that
7	you may have.

- MR. DAVID: We hope the hiring of Mr. Jones will be a momentous good happening for the town. look forward to him starting and is there anything else?
- MS. TAYLOR: No, just a -- hopefully a beginning of a mutually positive relationship between our Manager and Government and citizens, residents, and continue to move in our forward projection.
- MR. DAVID: Is there a motion to -- for Council to approve to hire the new Town Manager, Adrian Jones?

- 16 congratulations on your new baby.
- 17 MR. ZIMMERMAN: Thank you. Just left the hospital.
- 18 MS. TAYLOR: What's his name?
- 19 | MR. ZIMMERMAN: My name is Shawn Zimmerman.
- 20 MR. DAVID: What's the baby's name?
- 21 MS. CHEATHAM: What's the baby's name?
- 22 MR. ZIMMERMAN: Oh, I'm sorry. Robert, Robert
- Zimmerman.
- 24 MR. DAVID: Okay. That's okay, go ahead.
- 25 MS. TAYLOR: Happy birthday, Robert.

1	MR.	ZIMMERMAN: Thank you. I own Myrtle Beach
2		Watersports. I've been in business for 30
3		years in the Grand Strand. I think I'm trying
4		to I'm buying the business that's already
5		here and I think we're here just to see if the
6		Town approves it to take over. Do you want to
7		know more about me and what we do?

- MR. DAVID: Yeah, yeah. Give us a little bit.
- MR. ZIMMERMAN: Okay. So we've been in business 30 We do jet skis, pontoon boats, tritoon years. We have the Sea Screamer, the Sea boats. They do 150 passenger dolphin tours Thunder. out in the ocean. I don't know if you've seen the yellow -- the yellow boats out in the ocean.
- MR. DAVID: Uh-huh.

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- MR. ZIMMERMAN: The Sea Thunder, and then I have a 80 foot pirate ship down at 501 for kids. And here we're gonna do jet ski rides, banana boats, and the chair and umbrella rentals on the beach.
- 22 MR. DAVID: And life guard.
- 23 MS. TAYLOR: And life quards.
- 24 MR. ZIMMERMAN: And -- correct, the life quarding.
- 25 The paperwork that I gave you, I'm sorry I

1 didn't bring it with me.

UNIDENTIFIED SPEAKER: They have it. They all have it.

MR. ZIMMERMAN: You guys all see all that there?

MR. DAVID: Yeah, yes.

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MR. ZIMMERMAN: Safety is our number one goal. been -- I've got letter of recommendations from my insurance company from people I lease from I did a little bit of investigation about -- very important about they have to be Red out of Cross certified. I hired a company Charlotte to come down and train. And then I have ocean rescue guys from Myrtle Beach that are gonna continue -- every two week they're gonna come and do continuous training to make sure that they can swim and do. The life quard thing is new to me but I'm very, you know -safety is very important to me. And I know with the beach being out there, probably need two life guards most of the time, but they're gonna advise me on -- I'm meeting with them on Thursday. They're actually here training right now.

- 6 MR. ZIMMERMAN: --- beautiful beach and it's a lot
- 7 of opportunity here.
- 8 MR. DAVID: Yes. We look forward to exploring all
- 9 of that.
- 10 MR. ZIMMERMAN: All right, thank you.
- 11 MR. DAVID: Yes.
- 12 MS. TAYLOR: Thank you.
- 13 MR. DAVID: Is there a motion on the floor to
- 14 approve the change of ownership and land name
- for a business, for Atlantic Watersports?
- 16 MR. CAMPBELL: So moved.
- 17 MR. DAVID: Is there a second?

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#### MANAGER'S REPORT:

- MS. CHEATHAM: Okay, thank you. We're getting ready to have a party, y'all. Bike Fest is here. -- as of today we have 31 vendors who have paid We are excited. and signed up. The portajohns will be delivered tomorrow. The biq office for the police headquarters is already here. We are getting our door painted at Town Hall. And so I am excited. We had a prayer vigil on Sunday to pray that nothing bad happen and to pray for success and good weather. Wе have hired a new police officer who will start one day this week we hope. Wе also settled a case that has been lingering since at least 13, 14 years.
- 17 MR. BOOKER: 13, 14 years.
  - MS. CHEATHAM: 13 or 14 years. So we are very pleased with that. We are continuing to accept business license payments. We've got some computer language talking, the systems don't actually talk to each other. But our payments are coming in and we'll have that straight. The food bank truck will be in town tomorrow. Normally they come on the fourth Thursday of

the month and they come on the side where we're
doing parking now. But they're gonna be across
the street. So please come. The food is for
anyone who lives in town and you have to sign
a piece of paper but it's good food. And last
week we were supposed to do the street painting
but the weather didn't cooperate. And so we're
gonna try and do it next week on the 27th. As
I get more details we will let you know.

## 18 **UPCOMING EVENTS:**

MS. CHEATHAM: And then -- like the summer concern series, Juneteenth, the budget will be presented on the 2nd of June, first reading and public hearing. We have the Juneteenth celebration as I said. We've got the summer concert series. I neglected to put the fifth one, November the 1st and 2nd. We're hoping

that can function. We'll come to that one.
And the Gullah Geechee Festival is Labor Day
weekend. We're getting a lot of excitement
around that in terms of sponsors, in terms of
activities. So the Town is really having a
good summer. So I'll be glad to answer any
questions that anyone might have.

- MR. DAVID: I want to make sure to point out for if anybody -- make sure we have the dates -- the Juneteenth Festival is June 21st.
- 11 MS. CHEATHAM: Thank you.

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- MR. DAVID: And I'm gonna read the concert dates out
  - MS. CHEATHAM: Okay.
    - --- just for everybody, too. MR. DAVID: Summer concert series, which is -- all of this is posted on our newly revamped website. The first concert in the series is July 19th and 20th, I think Lakeside and Brick will be there and maybe some other artists. The next concert series weekend will August 9th and 10th. The next one will be September 5th and 6th. The next one will be October 4th and 5th. next one will be November 1st and 2nd. And we will follow up with Gullah -- we'll follow in

the middle of that with Gullah Geechee
Festival, which again, is August 29th through
31st. For all these efforts we will have
vendors that will be able to vend. You can
find the vending information on the website
For the Gullah Geechee Festival, we will have
a cook-off competition. So if you're willing
to enter into the cook-off, we will have a
vendors as well. We will have a dinner or
Black, which is gonna be on August the 31st
We will have food and fun for everybody, we'll
have concerts out that day with Gullah Geeche
singers and Gullah Geechee performers. So it
should be a fun and festive day and please
check out our website for all the events that
are coming up for this summer.

MS. CHEATHAM: One more thing.

MR. DAVID: Yes, ma'am?

MS. CHEATHAM: The Town was honored last night by the Horry County Preservation Committee for our being placed on the National Register of Historic Places. And so the Historic Committee was there, I was there, Mayor Pro Tem, Mr. Booker was there, as well as Councilwoman Taylor. It was a really nice award. As soon

as I take it out of my car it will be hung up in the office.

MR. DAVID: And we will -- in addition to the street mural, we will have some murals that will be started to be painted next Tuesday on the -- on the -- starting on the fire station wall and over on the Town Hall wall. So we're excited about those and look forward to seeing how they look in the -- in reality. Any other comments, questions, anything from the dias?
