ATLANTIC BEACH PARKING PASS

RESIDENT PASS:

Residents are allowed to purchase a registration for their vehicle for \$100 that will allow for unlimited parking. These are available on a first come, first served basis for the first 25.

NON-RESIDENTS PASS:

Non-residents are allowed to register one vehicle and may purchase a pass for \$200. Limited to 200 being sold.

PASS INFORMTION

CAN I HAVE A DECAL FOR MY CARS AND GOLF CART?

No physical decals. When registering your vehicle, your license plate number or golf cart state registration number will be noted, and when it is scanned by our LPR technology, we will know your vehicle is exempt from parking fees

HOW WILL PARKING ENFORMENT KNOW THAT MY LICENSE PLATE IS VALID FOR FREE PARKING?

This year, enforcement will use LPR (License Plate Recognition) to validate plates. Scanned plates instantly confirm active registration.

VIOLATIONS

Violations may be paid online or by mail (checks payable to Pivot Parking). To request an administrative review, follow the instructions on the back of the citation within 15 days. For questions, call (843) 601-1105.

PARKING INFORMATION

Parking in Atlantic Beach is easy—with hourly rates, free side street parking, and free parking after 6 PM.

PARKING RATES

- Rates are \$3 per hour. Always refer to lot signage for specific information.
- Paid Parking is enforced 8 am 6 pm, 7 days per week (Mar- Sept)
- Right-of-way parking is enforced
 24 hours a day.
- Pay with ease—look for signs to pay by phone by texting or scanning QR code. All major credit cards accepted.

PARKING TIPS

- Parking Payment Options: Text parking code on signs to xxxx and follow prompts to register or scan OR code
- Snap a photo and enter your plate number correctly into your phone.
- Be sure you are familiar with all Town parking rules and regulations. You are responsible for how you are parked!
- Always pay for at least the minimum time—Parking
 Ambassadors don't know how long you intended to park.
- Always follow posted parking signage.
