6. Approval of Minutes - *None*

- A. **Ordinance No. 6- 2026 - An Amendment to Ordinance No. 6-2025** to correct the Town Council Rules of Procedure, including, but not limited to, the correction of an incorrect ordinance number, and to authorize Town Council to implement such corrections and reformat the document in compliance with the South Carolina Code of Laws and recognized best practices. ***Second Reading***
- B. **Ordinance No. 8-2026 – An Ordinance Amending the Business License Ordinance No. 7-2026 of the Town of Atlantic Beach to Update the Class Schedule as Required by Act 176 of 2020.** The South Carolina Business License Tax Standardization Act (Act 176) requires all municipalities levying a local business license tax to standardize their licensing process. Adoption aligns the Town of Atlantic Beach with state law by establishing a uniform May 1 – April 30 license year, accepting the standard state application form, enabling online payment through the SC Local Business License Renewal Center, and classifying businesses by NAICS code. These changes streamline compliance for local businesses and ensure the City's processes are consistent with statewide requirements. All ordinances or parts of ordinances previously adopted by the Town that are inconsistent or in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict. ***Second Reading***.

**A. Resolution No. 9-2026** – A Resolution authorizing the transfer of the Town’s Municipal Court and Police Seized Funds bank accounts from United Community Bank to First Citizens Bank.

**B. Resolution No. 10-2026** – A Resolution authorizing the Establishment of a Separate Bank Account for ATAX Funds Received for the Special Advertising and Promotion of Tourism and for Depositing Interest Earnings into a Special Fund for Tourism-Related Expenditures

**C. Resolution No. 11-2026 – ARPA Contract Administrative Amendment**

This ARPA Contract Administrative modification is requested by Horry County to remove grant language referring to the contract being reimbursable. The grant was awarded to the Town of Atlantic Beach in 2023 to install solar lighting and EV charging stations. The grant was awarded to cover the full cost of the project and had no reimbursements due from the Town. This administrative modification has no financial impact and will only remove the reference of the contract being a reimbursable agreement.
