 - A. Ordinance No. 8-2026 – An Ordinance Amending the Business License Ordinance No. 7-2026 of the Town of Atlantic Beach to Update the Class Schedule as Required by Act 176 of 2020.**

The South Carolina Business License Tax Standardization Act (Act 176) requires all municipalities levying a local business license tax to standardize their licensing process. Adoption aligns the Town of Atlantic Beach with state law by establishing a uniform May 1 – April 30 license year, accepting the standard state application form, enabling online payment through the SC Local Business License Renewal Center, and classifying businesses by NAICS code. These changes streamline compliance for local businesses and ensure the City's processes are consistent with statewide requirements. All ordinances or parts of ordinances previously adopted by the Town that are inconsistent or in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict. **Second Reading.**
