These changes streamline compliance for local businesses and ensure the City’s processes are consistent with statewide requirements. Retires the outdated classification framework. Brings the Town into compliance with the South Carolina Business License Tax Standardization Act (Act 176). Act 176 requires all municipalities levying a local business license tax to standardize their licensing process. The adoption aligns the Town with state law by classifying businesses by updated NAICS code. **Second Reading.**
